The Illinois Public Health Association is excited to announce the availability of four(4) scholarships for the 2023-2024 academic year for qualified graduate students in public health.



Edith Heide Memorial Scholarship

One (1) scholarship in the amount of \$2,000

Graduate Study in Public Health Scholarship

Three (3) scholarships in the amount of \$1,000 each

Goal

The program goal is to contribute to increasing the number of Public Health professionals in Illinois by supporting the efforts of Illinois residents seeking advanced degrees in Public Health.

Eligibility

Must be a citizen of the United States, a resident of Illinois, and enrolled in a public health-related graduate degree program at a recognized and accredited university in Illinois.

Guidelines

Scholarship assistance may be used toward the payment of tuition and fees only.

Recipients of scholarships may apply, and be considered, for support for a second year.

Award

The applicant with the highest score will receive an Edith Heide scholarship and the second through fourth place applicants will each receive an IPHA Scholarship for Graduate Study in Public Health. If the scholarship recipient is not a current IPHA member, they will be given a one-year student membership.

Disbursement

Upon verification of enrollment, the Illinois Public Health Association will send the scholarship funds directly to the financial aid office of the recipient's college or university.
